BIM is the development and use of a multi-faceted computer software data model to not only documental building design, but to simulate the construction and operation of a new capital facility or a recapitalised (modernized) facility. The resulting Building Information Model is a data –rich , object –based, intelligent and parametric digital representation of the facility, from which views appropriate to various users needs can be extracted and analyzed to generate feedback and improvement of the facility design.


In two day workshop students get dual certification i.e. certificate of Mobile Making as well as certificate of IoT.


