Countries got a high amount of COVID-19 infections and many people died. Keeping this in mind, the Government of India announced a nationwide lockdown. This was a vital step in putting brakes on the infection rate. But this sudden announcement, though necessary, came as a huge burden on the whole nation. All workplaces, except the essential sector, came to a standstill and people were told to stay indoors as the deadly virus started to spread rapidly. Transportations stopped, so people were unable to move from one place to another. So, people were both out of work and were unable to go home. The people who suffered most because of this situation were the migrant workers. Most of the people in India, who fall under the poverty line, relocate to bigger cities for jobs. While they are already challenged in terms of survival, the lockdown was an add-on to their miseries. Neither were they able to earn to feed their families nor were they able to travel back home for survival, putting them in deep trouble. Seeing their grave situation, NSS Unit of Jagadambha College Of Engineering And Technology Yavatmal came forward to provide them with free food for survival. There were total 05 faculty members and 20 students who distributed the free food packets to the poor and needy people in yavatmal city.



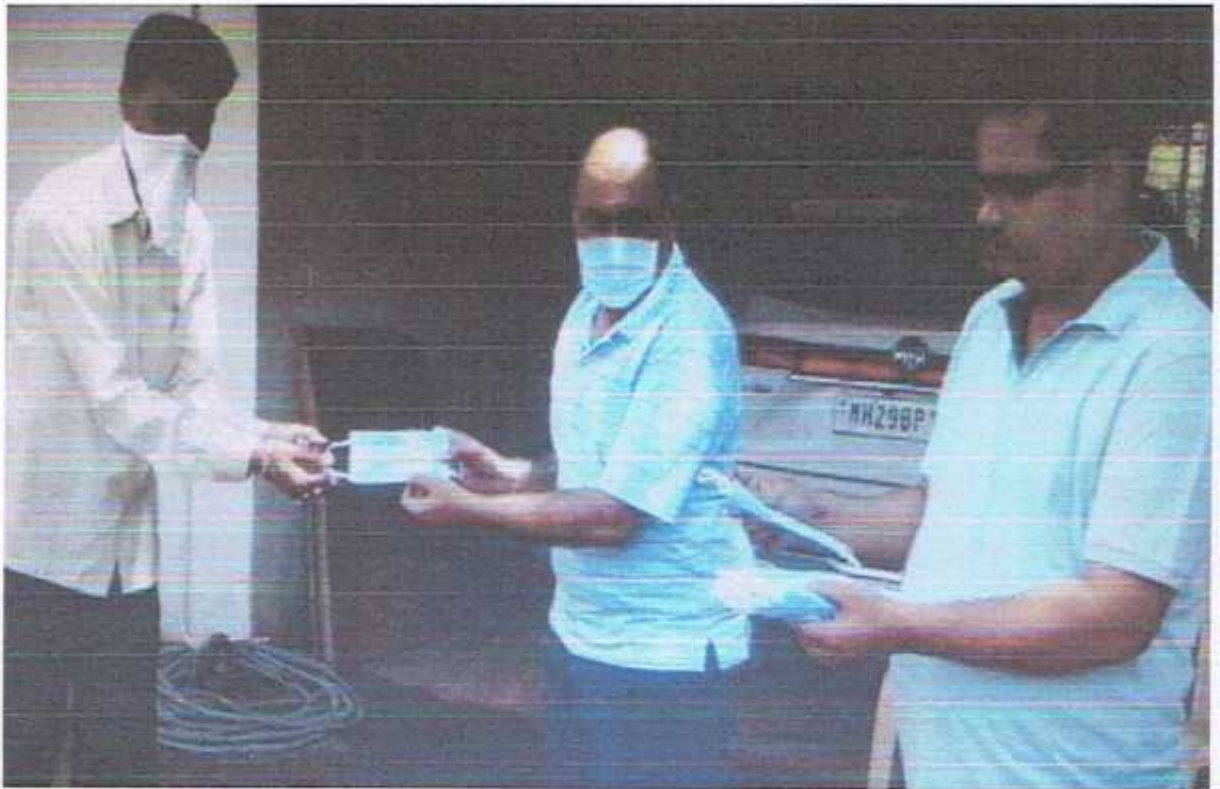

The NSS unit of Jagadambha College of Engineering & Technology Yavatmal Provides Bus facility to the relocation of migrant labour who are from other states. India has been in lockdown since March 25, 2020. During this time, activities not contributing to the production and supply of essential goods and services were completely or partially suspended. Passenger trains and flights were halted. The lockdown has severely impacted migrants, several of whom lost their jobs due to shutting of industries and were stranded outside their native places wanting to get back. Since then, the government has announced relief measures for migrants, and made arrangements for migrants to return to their native place. The Supreme Court of India, recognizing the problems faced by migrants stranded in different parts of the country, reviewed transportation and relief arrangements made by the government. On June 9, the Court directed central and state governments to complete transportation of remaining stranded migrants and expand focus of relief measures to facilitate employment for returning migrants. In this blog, we highlight some facts about migration in India, summarize key relief measures announced by the government and directives issued by the Supreme Court for the migrant population in relation to the lockdown. During Covid-19 pandemic situation the labour from other states faced lots of issue like food, shelter, health issue, daily wages, so they have to relocate their location to their hometown and this need of migrant labour is identified by the Jagadambha College of Engineering & Technology Yavatmal and decided to provide the bus facility to the migrant labour so that they can relocate to their location and back to the home.

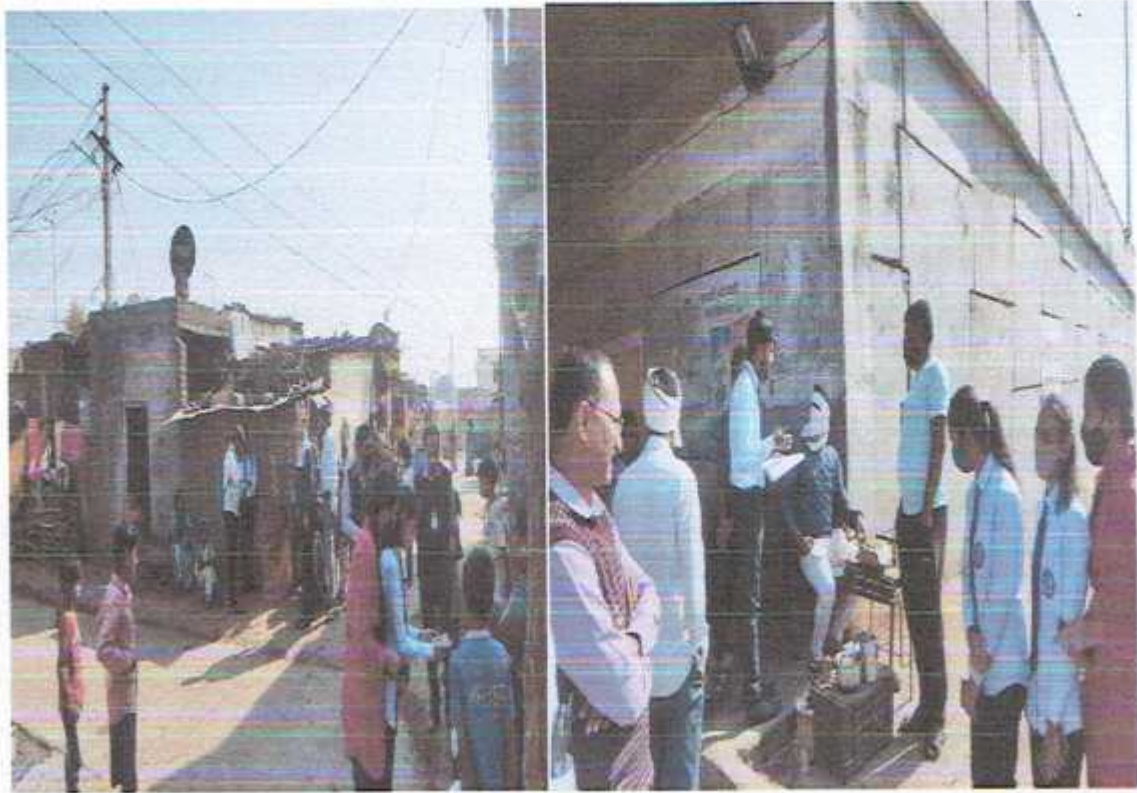

The NSS unit of Jagadambha college of Engineering & technology Yavatmal organized the online webinar on Covid-19 doubts and concerns. In view of the world wide spread of Corona Virus, Dr. H. M. Baradkar, Principal of the college has inaugurated the initiative with his valuable speech addressing the students. He also stressed on "Not to Panic" but to follow the rules to get rid of the infection. In this programme, a good number of students representing different departments of the college under the guidance of Dr. V. L. Bhambere, IQAC have actively participated to aware the students, staff and visitors in the college during the programme. The programme informed about the "DOs" & "DON'Ts" to be followed to get rid of the disease as the infection is very contagious in nature causing serious health problems to the people of many countries including India.

Special Guest Dr. Dipak Agrawal addresses the students & staff regarding all the concerns related to the vaccination. They share the difference between all the types of vaccines available for the people that is covishield, covaxin, sputnik etc. According to his guidance they are suggested to the staff & student to do their vaccination due in a period of time and the slots suggested by the WHO in a period depending upon the age of the person.

Benefits of vaccination for the community

Vaccination protects the vaccinated persons and those around them who are vulnerable to the diseases, reducing the risk of diseases spreading among family members, school mates or colleagues, friends, neighbours and other people in the community. When enough people in a population are immune to an infectious disease, the disease is then unlikely to spread from person to person. This is known as '**community immunity**' (also referred to as 'herd immunity').



In this way, vaccines indirectly protect others who are vulnerable to disease. These include babies, children, the elderly, and people with weak immune systems, cancer patients, and people who cannot be vaccinated for medical reasons.

It means that people who cannot be vaccinated, for instance because they are too young or allergic to vaccine components, benefit from others being vaccinated, because the disease cannot easily spread in the community.

For example, to ensure community immunity against measles, public health authorities recommend that **95% of the population are vaccinated** with two doses of the vaccine against measles (the MMR vaccine, which protects against measles, mumps and rubella).

However, people **cannot rely on community immunity** for some infectious diseases. For example, tetanus can be encountered due to common injuries, including dog or cat bites. Vaccination is the only way to ensure direct protection against tetanus.

Furthermore, immunisation programmes help reduce the social, psychological and financial burdens of disease on people and governments, reducing pressures on healthcare and social care systems and enabling people to pursue productive activities including education and employment.

At the last Dr. Dipak Agrawal advised to all that everyone can follow the covid-19 guidelines and do our vaccination as early as possible. Then the program was end by vote of thanks proposed by NSS Incharge prof. P. S. Wankhade sir.

Why vaccines are important:

- Vaccination is the most important thing we can do to protect ourselves and our children against ill health. They prevent up to 3 million deaths worldwide every year.
- Since vaccines were introduced in the UK, diseases like smallpox, polio and tetanus that used to kill or disable millions of people are either gone or seen very rarely.
- Other diseases like measles and diphtheria have been reduced by up to 99.9% since their vaccines were introduced.
- However, if people stop having vaccines, it's possible for infectious diseases to quickly spread again.
- The World Health Organization (WHO) has listed vaccine hesitancy as one of the biggest threats to global health.
